USA Volleyball/HOA PARTICIPANT CODE OF CONDUCT

THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS ARE PROHIBITED

- 1) Violation of any anti-doping policies, protocols or procedures as defined by the international Olympic Committee (IOC), World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), Federation International de Volleyball (FIVB), US Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) or the United States Olympic Committee (USOC). Violations of this provision will be adjudicated only by USADA or the proper anti-doping authority, not USA Volleyball (USAV)
- 2) Possession, consumption or distribution of alcohol and / or tobacco if illegal or in violation of USAV or HOA policy.
- 3) USAV policy prohibits the possession, consumption or distribution of alcohol and/or tobacco by anyone registered as a Junior Olympic Volleyball Player at the event venue of any USAV sanctioned junior event.
- 4) Use of a recognized identification card by anyone other than the individual described on the card.
- 5) Physical damage to a facility or theft of items from a room, dormitory, residence or other person. (Restitution will be a part of any penalty imposed.)
- 6) Possession of fireworks, ammunition, firearms or other weapons or any item or material which by commonly accepted practices and principles would be a hazard or harmful to other persons at USAV sanctioned events.
- 7) Any action considered to be an offense under Federal, State or local law ordinances.
- 8) Violation of the specific policies, regulations, and/or procedures of HOA, USAV or the facility used in conjunction with a sanctioned event. (It is the responsibility of the individual to be familiar with applicable specific policies, regulations, and procedures).
- 9) Conduct which is inappropriate as determined by comparison to normally accepted behavior.
- 10) Physical or verbal intimidation of any individual.
- 11) Actions that will be detrimental to USAV or HOA

USA Volleyball/HOA DISCIPLINARY POLICY

Infraction	When Occurred	Suggested Maximum Penalty**
First	Before or during event	Individual disqualified (if person is a junior, she/he will be sent home as soon as possible and parent or guardian notified). The individual may be declared ineligible for HOA membership or USAV registration for one year starting from the date of infraction.
	After event concludes	The individual may be declared ineligible for HOA membership or USAV registration for one year starting from the date of infraction.
Second	Before or during event	Individual disqualified (if the person is a junior, she/he will be sent home as soon as possible and parent or guardian notified). The individual may be declared ineligible for USAV registration or HOA membership for two years starting from the date of the infraction.
	After event concludes	The individual may be declared ineligible for HOA membership or USAV registration for two years starting from the date of infraction.
Third		Individual may be immediately declared ineligible for HOA membership or USAV registration for the remainder of his/her lifetime.

NOTE: Major misbehavior (e.g. verbal or physical abuse of a child, sexual harassment, etc.) may subject the violator to immediate lifetime ineligibility for HOA membership or USAV registration after the first infraction. Penalties are only applied after affording the participant due process may be required by the Ted Stevens Olympic and Amateur Sports Act (TSOASA), USOC, HOA and USAV. Appeals other than for doping violations, may be made in accordance with procedures set forth in the bylaws and operating codes of HOA and USA Volleyball as posted on the HOA website (www.hoavb.org) and Official USA Volleyball Guide, respectively.

I acknowledge that volleyball or any sporting event is an extreme test of a person's physical and mental limits and that my participation in a volleyball event can cause potential death, serious injury or property damage. **With a full understanding of the potential risks, I HEREBY ASSUME THE RISKS OF PARTICIPATING OR OFFICIATING IN A VOLLEYBALL EVENT.**

I hereby take the following action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns:

a) **I WAIVE, RELEASE, AND DISCHARGE** from any and all claims or liabilities for death or personal injury or damages of any kind, **EXCEPT THAT WHICH IS THE RESULT OF GROSS NEGLIGENCE AND/OR WANTON MISCONDUCT OF PERSONS OR ENTITIES LISTED BELOW**, which arise out of or relate to my traveling to and from my participation in any volleyball event, **THE FOLLOWING PERSONS OR ENTITIES:** USA Volleyball and its Regional Volleyball Associations, tournament directors, sponsors, and the officers, directors, employees, representatives and agents of any of the above;

b) **I AGREE NOT TO SUE** any persons or entities listed above for any of the claims or liabilities that I have waived, released or discharged herein; and

c) **I INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS** the persons or entities mentioned above from any claims made or liabilities assessed against them as a result of my actions.

In consideration of the rights and privileges granted to me by signing this membership form, I certify that

1. I have read and completed all sections of this membership application;
2. I have read and understand the HOA and USAV Codes of Conduct, Disciplinary Policies, and Waiver and Release of Liability;
3. I understand that the Codes of Conduct, Disciplinary Policies, and Waiver and Release of Liability apply to my conduct in all activities or events sanctioned or sponsored by HOA and USA Volleyball in which I participate;
4. I (or my parent or legal guardian) am at least eighteen (18) years old;
5. I agree and consent to abide by the HOA and USAV Codes of Conduct, Disciplinary Policies and Waiver and Release of Liability set forth herein
6. I understand that, if I violate the HOA or USAV Codes of conduct, I might be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with HOA or USAV Disciplinary Policies.
